

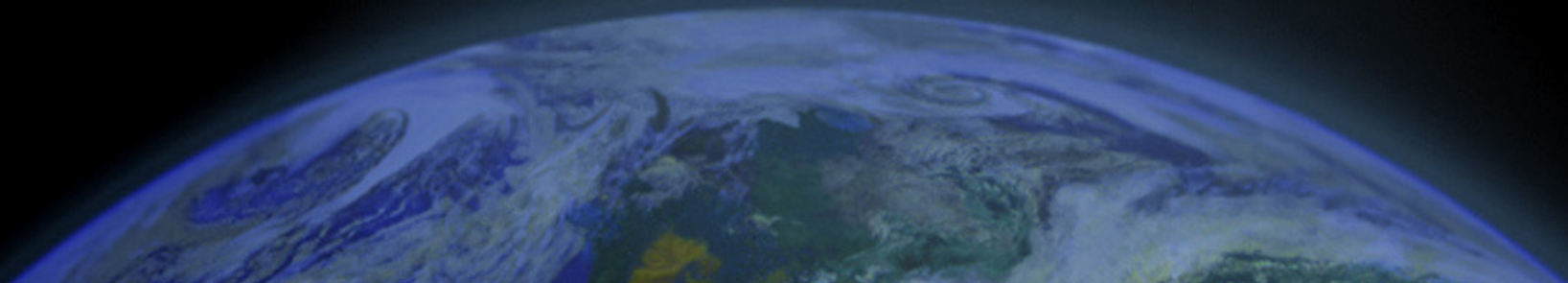

Now the Lord had **prepared a great fish** to swallow Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

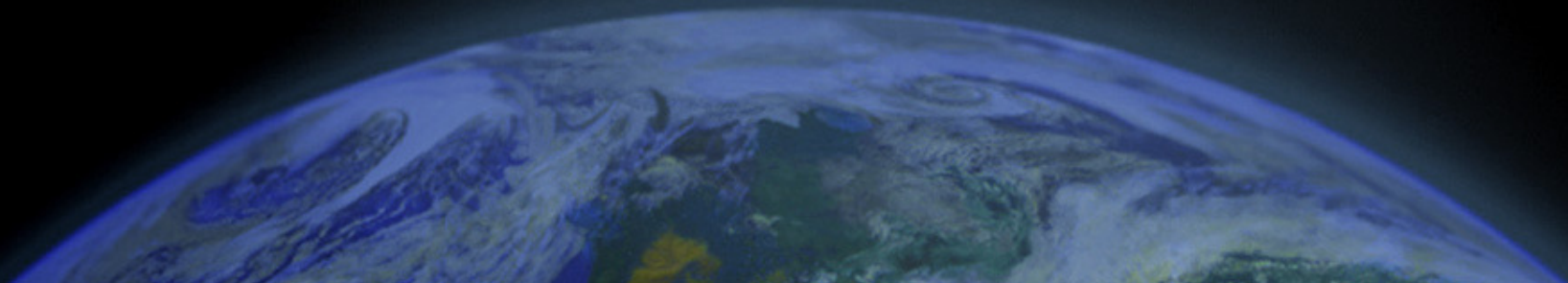


Jonah 2

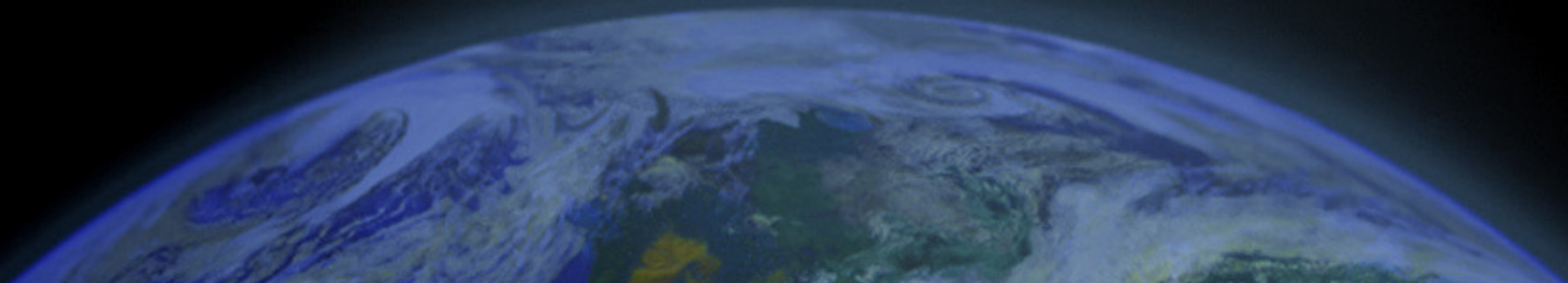
3:5 So the people of Nineveh believed God



Jonah 4

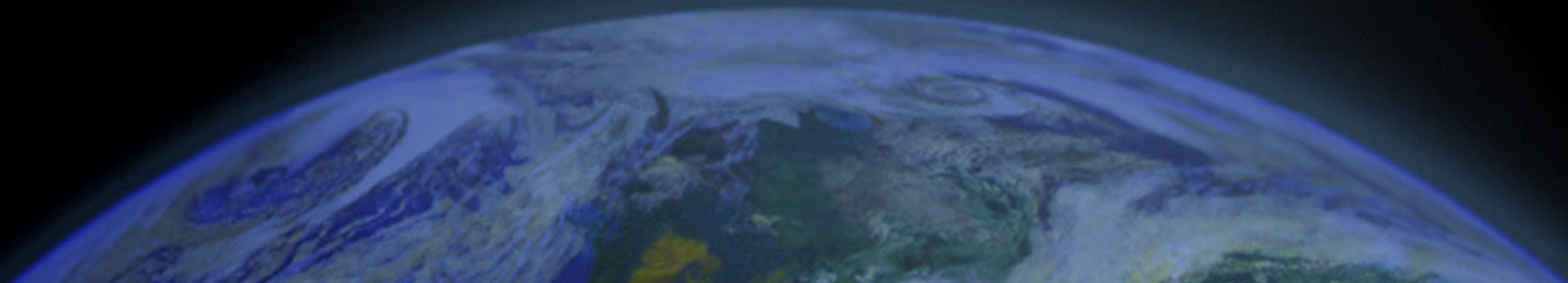
Jonah Gets Mad
