

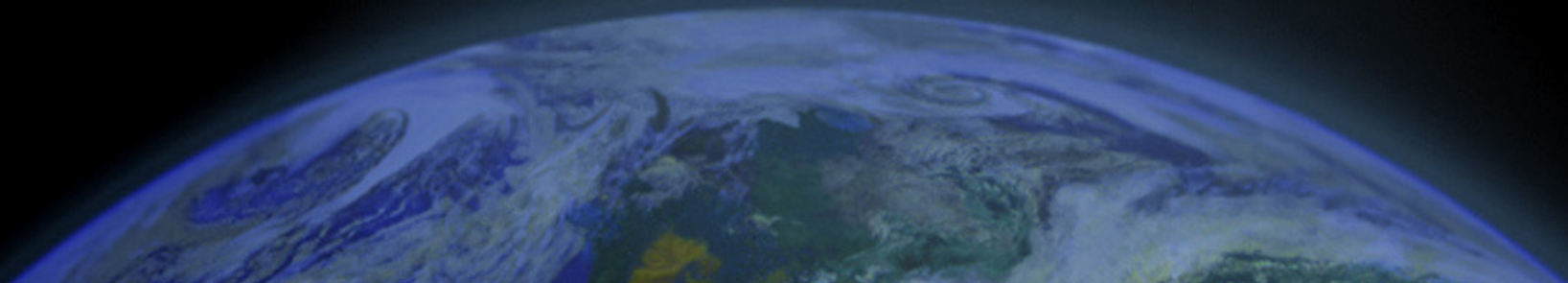

4. He saw his mission (verses 8-13)



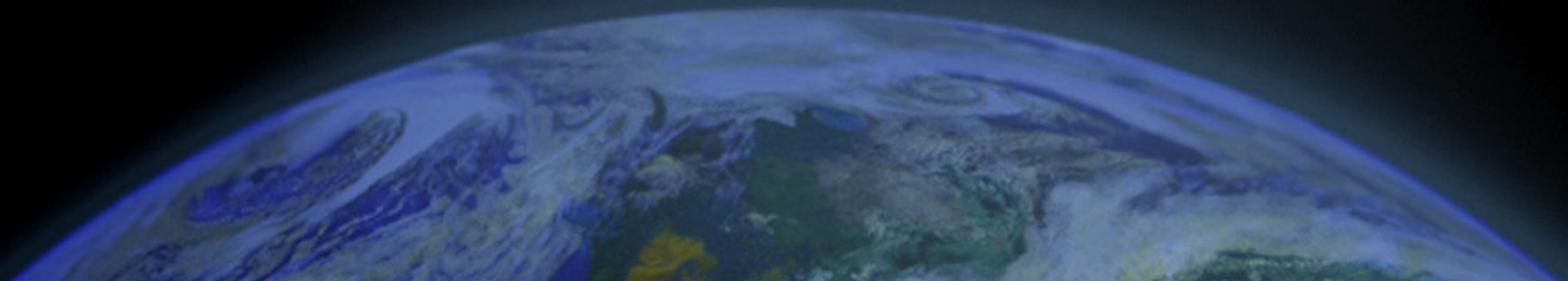
What You See & Understand Is What You Tend to Become

Paul says, “we all, with unveiled face, continue to behold as in a mirror at the glory of the Lord, [and] are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord” (2 Corinthians 3:18).

(Not Bad & Good)

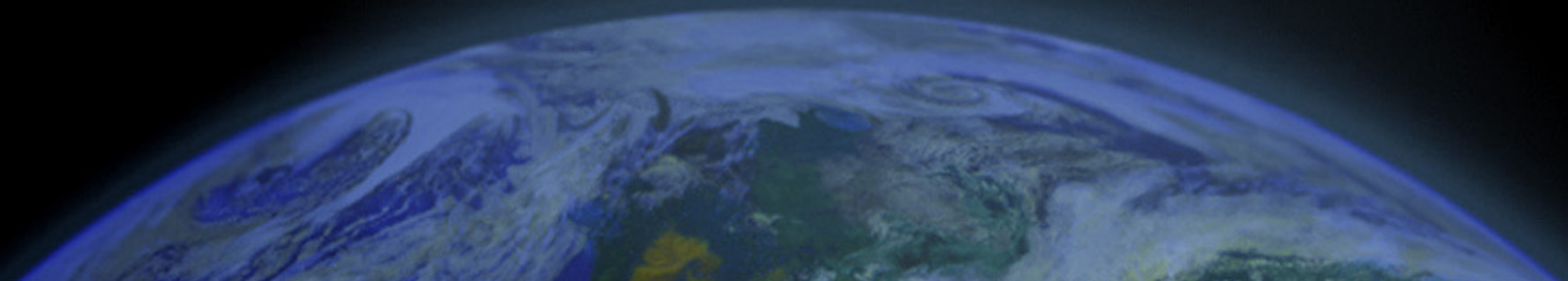
2 Corinthians 3:7-18
